Some courses in M.A Programme are traditional classics, but some directly deal with the culture, environment, society etc. They play a vital role in making the students aware of their rich cultural tradition. The Department organize special lecture, seminars etc. time to time highlighting various aspects of Buddhist Studies, the faculty are invited by various Academic Institutions to delivered public lecture on the Buddhism such programe create general awareness about the subject.

Strength

Weakness

- Infrastructure and staff need to be strengthened.

Besides, linguistic studies of Pali, Sanskrit, Chinese, Tibetan etc. Buddhist Studies also imparts education in History, Art, Archaeology etc. But our students do not get any financial support for education tour, due to which they remain bereft from acquiring practical knowledge of Buddhist Studies.

Opportunities

- i. Recently the J&K Govt. has introduced Buddhist Studies at 10+2 level Schools. This will pave way for generation of employment for our post graduates.
- ii. Our students get teaching positions in subjects like History, Philosophy, Art Archaeology etc. in various other University of India and abroad. There is also potential for the same in our institutions.
- iii. Buddhist studies is a very popular subject in the south East and East Asian countries and even in the Universities of western world. If proper facilities are provided in terms of teachers with specialization in different branches of Buddhist Studies, Language Laboratory, Archaeological tool etc. foreign scholars may be invited to study as well as to teach and train our students.

Challenges

The modern age is that of science, technology, computer and internet subjects of humanity, region and culture are endangered. To compete with the challenges Buddhist Studies, as a discipline is required to be revamped with logical and National interpretation and socially usefulness. We have to make it more attractive and job oriented. As such Buddhist Tourism, Engaged Buddhism etc. are to be included in the syllabi.
