



# **UNIVERSITY OF JAMMU: AN OVERVIEW**

Established in 1969 following bifurcation of the erstwhile University of Jammu and Kashmir, University of Jammu is spread over seven Offsite Campuses at Kathua, Bhaderwah, Udhampur, Poonch, Ramnagar, Reasi and Kishtwar. Accredited as A-Grade University by the National Assessment and Accreditation Council of India (NAAC), University of Jammu has a mission to become a globally recognised institution of rigorous academic research and teaching. The University offers around 45 post-graduate degree/diploma courses and 18 under-graduate courses including five-year Integrated Law. The University hosts faculties including Sciences, Life Sciences, Arts, Social Sciences, Business Studies, Education, Behavioural Sciences, Law, Oriental Learning, Medicine, Engineering, Music and Fine Arts and Ayurvedic Medicine. The University offers Doctoral Programmes (Ph.D) across all the disciplines/ faculties. The University has 29 Government Colleges and around 110 Private Colleges affiliated to it. The University of Jammu is a Wi-Fi Campus with excellent IT facilities.

The University hosts well equipped Central Library:

Dhanvantri, with over 6 Lac books with EBSCO,

LIBSYS softwares, CD-ROM database, INFLIBNET,

RFID and interconnected computer terminals and the International Resource Centre. The University also hosts the state-of-the-art General Zorawar Singh auditorium, well-equipped gymnasium and fitness/health centre, child day-care centre, canteens and cafeteria. The University also provides separate hostel facility for boys and girls. Besides, the University also has Academic Staff College for undertaking training of faculty members across disciplines, Directorate of Distance Education for distance learning programmes, Department of Life-Long Learning, Women Studies Centre, Centre for Strategic Studies, International Centre for Cross-Cultural Research and Human Resource Management, Directorate of Quality Assurance, etc. Organising Conferences/Seminars/ Workshops/ Youth Festivals/Cultural, Literary and Sports activities is a regular feature in the University. University is actively engaged in extension and outreach activities. Over four thousand students join the post-graduate courses on the Campus each Academic Session (includes the figure for private/ affiliated colleges).

## **KATHUA CAMPUS: AN OVERVIEW**



Kathua Campus is fast emerging as the technical Campus of University of Jammu. Currently MBA and MCA programmes are being offered at the Campus. The other programmes like B. Pharma, Five-Year integrated MBA and the various Engineering Programmes through the University Institute of Engineering and Technology (UIET) are in the pipeline, for augmenting quality and technical education and research. Kathua Campus is working with technological focus, futuristic outlook and social sensitivity.

Personality and skill development workshops, industry-academia interactions as well as extension and special sessions are regularly organized at the Campus for facilitating placement processes. Interactive teaching-learning, career counselling and mentoring, extension and outreach are seen as the prime concerns at the Campus. Students' needs, aspirations and interests are addressed on one-to-one basis by the committed faculty and the staff. The use of ICT is encouraged at the Campus. The continuous evaluation system throughout the Semester, gears up the learning skills with a desired pace. Sports and cultural activities are promoted at the Campus for the overall development of the students.

The placements at the Campus for the MBA and MCA programmes are centrally managed through the Office of Dean Student Placements at the University of Jammu, Jammu. The Placement Coordinator at the Campus works in close coordination with the Office of the Dean Student Placements, University of Jammu for the said

purpose. The Campus is well equipped with Computer Labs, Video Conferencing facility, Smart Classrooms, Seminar Room, Common Recreation Room, Transport facility etc.

Equal importance is placed on the cultural, literary and sporting activities at Kathua Campus. Kathua Campus is organising Inter-College Cultural and Literary Fest ANUSHTHAN -2014 under the theme "Celebrating Culture and Festivity" in November 2014. Also, after the 1st National Research Conference on 'Business Dynamics' in March 2013 in collaboration with National HRD Network, The Management School at Kathua Campus is all set to announce the CALL FOR PAPERS for the 2nd National Research Conference scheduled for February / March 2015.

About 362 Kanals of land has been acquired at Village Janglote, Kathua, where separate hostels for boys and girls, academic and administrative blocks are near completion stage. The Campus shall move from the rented premises to the newly constructed Academic block (G plus 3) towards the end of this Year. All the upcoming buildings are environment friendly and equipped with modern facilities. Ministry of HRD, Government of India has sanctioned the University Institute of Engineering and Technology (UIET) at Kathua Campus under Rashtriya Uchchatar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) with the financial support of 26 Crores. The UIET shall come up in 50-60 Kanals of land at Janglote, Kathua along with the other buildings.

# **TEACHING DEPARTMENTS**

#### The Management School (TMS)

The MBA programme at Kathua Campus commenced in the year 2006 in The Management School at the Campus. The MBA admissions are made on the basis of Common Admission Test (CAT)/AIMA – MAT score as one of the parameters of selection process through centralized process at The Business School at the main Campus. The total in-take in a batch is 30 seats (including the reserved category seats). There is also a provision of 5 seats under the self-financed category, which are over and above the number of 30 seats.

The TMS is working with a mission to build up value centric leadership through education which is entrepreneurial in spirit, ethical in focus and global in orientation. In doing this, we seek to develop management professionals with creative and inquisitive minds blended with empathy for others.

## Department of Computer Science and IT

Department of Computer Science and IT was established at the University of Jammu (Main Campus) in the year 1987, with the objective of imparting quality education in the field of Computer Science. The MCA programme started in Kathua Campus in the year 2012. The objective of

the Master's of Computer Applications (MCA) programme at Kathua is to impart core education in Computer Science and its applications, so that students are well prepared to face the challenges of IT industry. The course structure ensures overall development of the students, while concentrating on imparting technical skills required for an IT professional.

All the labs, offices and faculty rooms of the Department are equipped with Wi fi internet facility. Internet connectivity is provided using 6 different lines and one wimax Line to all systems in the laboratory, classrooms, seminar room and Smart Class room. ## **TEACHING PEDAGOGY**

A variety of teaching and learning methods are employed to impart knowledge and skills to students at Kathua Campus. Lectures, case analysis, simulation games and exercises, syndicates, group discussions and practical project work, laboratory work are commonly used to develop conceptual, analytical and decision making skills. The preparation is also in the direction of instilling enabling capabilities amongst the students so as to face the challenges of the complex business environment. The lectures are mostly delivered with the help of overhead projectors (OHP) and Liquid Crystal Display (LCD) Projectors in interactive smart classrooms. The Campus also provides the video conferencing facility to the students to interact with the experts from both industry and academia at national and international level. The continuous evaluation system throughout the Semester gears up the learning skills with a desired pace. Interactions of the students with guest speakers from corporate and academia are a regular feature to further professional development.



# **SUMMER TRAINING/PROFESSIONAL TRAINING**

Component of Summer Training/ Professional Training in MBA and MCA curriculum respectively of University of Jammu contributes significantly towards the professional development of the participants in these programmes.

## **SUMMER TRAINING (MBA)**

After completing their first two semesters of instruction during the first year, all the MBA students are required to undertake practical training in an organization for a period of about 8 weeks during the summer months. Each student is selected by a reputed company wherein he/she works on an assigned live project under the supervision of a designated corporate supervisor. After completion of the training, the student is required to submit a report to the company as well as to the University of Jammu as one of the statutory requirements in the partial fulfillment of the MBA programme. The projects are duly evaluated and assigned weightage in the semester 3rd of the MBA programme.

#### PROJECT WORK (MCA)

After completing their five semesters of instruction during the first two and half years, all

the MCA students are required to undertake project work of minimum four to six months duration. Each student shall carry out the project in the concerned Department/Other Institution/Organization as approved by the Department under the supervision of a teacher assigned by the Department and has to develop an application for the concerned organization. Each student will submit a synopsis at the beginning of the semester for approval from the Department. The student will have to present the progress of the work through Mid-Semester Presentation after two months duration.



#### INFRASTRUCTURE AND ICT







The Campus is equipped with state-of-the-art infrastructure as follows:

#### **COMPUTER LAB**

Keeping in pace with the latest advances in Technology and Management, Kathua Campus brings the most sophisticated and modern technology to its students. The Campus is equipped with state-of-the-art air-conditioned Computer labs with computers and work stations.

# VIDEO CONFERENCING LAB & SMART CLASSROOMS

The Campus provides Video Conferencing facility to the students and the faculty, whereby interactions are a possibility through Webinar and networks. Formal interactions are hosted with the academicians and the corporate experts through virtual / e-learning mode. Interactive sessions, panel discussions and workshops are organized and conducted in the designated smart/interactive classrooms. The facilitators make use of the technology to support teaching-learning process.

#### **LIBRARY**

The library at Kathua Campus is fully equipped with latest books (text and reference) in Management, Computer Sciences, Information Technology and allied disciplines. The library also subscribes to various management Journals and Magazines. Students at the Campus are encouraged to visit library on regular basis. The Campus library is supported by the Dhanwantri Library at University of Jammu, Jammu, with over 6 lac books with LIBSYS software, CD-ROM database, INFLIBNET, RIFD and inter-connected computer terminals and International Resource Centre. The Campus also has access to research on-line databases subscribed by University of Jammu like EBSCO, etc.

#### **COMMON RECREATION ROOM**

An indoor facility to promote interaction amongst the participants exist in the campus in the form of a common recreation room. Students like to involve themselves in indoor sporting activities like Carrom, Chess etc.

#### TRANSPORT FACILITY

The Campus offers transport facility (bus facility) to the students who commute on daily basis from Jammu and the nearby areas on the route.
