

**STATUTES GOVERNING POST-GRADUATE DIPLOMA IN  
COMPOSITE CULTURE MANAGEMENT (PGDCCM)**

1. The duration of the course leading to the Post-Graduate Diploma in Composite Culture Management (hereinafter referred to as 'Diploma') shall be one year. The entire programme shall be divided into two semesters. There shall be an examination called the Semester Examination at the end of each Semester in the prescribed courses for students having undergone a regular PGDCCM course of study in the Department of ICccR & HRM. The examination in the 1st and the 2nd Semester shall be held ordinarily in December/January and June/July, respectively.
2. The total number of seats in the course are 30 and shall be filled as per University of Jammu norms and guidelines for open and reserved categories.
3. Admission to the PGDCCM Programme shall be through Common University Entrance Test (CUET). The minimum qualification for admission to the First Semester of the PGDCCM Programme course shall be Bachelor's Degree in any discipline of this University of Jammu or an equivalent examination of any other recognized University with at least 45% marks in the aggregate, excluding the additional optional paper/s, if any, and as laid down in CUET Brochure/guidelines.
4. The nature, number, scope and content of each course of the Diploma Programme, contact hours and the duration of examination in each course in a semester shall be as per existing University of Jammu statutes for PG Diploma in Composite Culture Management programme.
5. Candidates selected for admission to the Diploma Programme shall have to pursue regular classwork and, undertake academic work as per syllabus and appear in the First and Second semester examinations as per the prescribed courses and norms. The Diploma Certificate shall be issued by the Controller of Examination, University of Jammu.
6. Instructions in each course shall be in the form of lectures, tutorials, seminars, problem sessions, case studies, group discussions etc., i.e. according to the needs of each course as may be decided by the Board of Studies in ICccR & HRM, Faculty of Business Studies.
