The city hosts the famous Raghunath Temple, Bagh-e-Bahu, Bahu Fort etc., within the municipal limits. The famous Vaishno Devi shrine is about 55 km from Jammu.

ABOUT THE CONFERENCE

The abstract should include title, name(s) of the author/co-author and organization, their address including e-mail. The name of the presenting author should be in bold. The abstract should be submitted electronically in 'MS Word file to the e-mail id: **nwisasociologyju@gmail.com** on or before 25-02-2024.
