2. **Record of discussions held and decisions taken is as under:**

Initiating the proceedings, Chancellor welcomed all members in the meeting of the Council.

i/ **The Vice Chancellor made a power point presentation on the recent initiatives of the University concerning the following:**

During the presentation the Vice Chancellor highlighted the following major achievements of the University:

- RUSA-I, ₹ 20 crores were sanctioned in 2015
- RUSA-II ₹ 100 crores were sanctioned during 2018-19 along with 9 other Universities of the Country
- NAAC grade A+ (3.51), Conferment of Category-I University status with full autonomy by the UGC; Performance in RUSA-I was very good.

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- The Business School has been granted accreditation (2019-2022) for its flagship MBA program by the prestigious National Board of Accreditation, (NBA) and All India Council for Technical Education(AICTE).
- School of Biotechnology, Ranked A by Evaluation conducted by Department of Biotechnology, Govt. of India: Being one amongst top 10 Departments of the Country; Selected for further funding by DBT for 5 years (2020-25).
- Recognition by Department of Science and Technology (DST), Govt. of India Promotion of Research & Scientific Excellence Programme (PURSE I and II) Phase I: ₹ 9.00 Crore; Phase II: ₹ 16.75 Crore
- UGC – Special Assistance Programme (SAP) awarded to Department of Botany, Education, Environmental Sciences
- Department of Science and Technology (DST) – Fund for improvement of Science and Technology (FIST) awarded to Department of Biotechnology, Zoology, Geography
- Ongoing Research projects: 42; grants allocated 37 crores
- Established a Section 8 company under the Companies Act, 2013, named as University of Jammu Special Purpose Vehicle Foundation.
- Sanction of Atal Community Innovation Centre by Atal Innovation Mission, NITI Aayog.

The Vice Chancellor also apprised the Council about the following efforts made by the University during Covid-19 lockdown period:

- Creation of Quarantine /Covid-19 Wellness Centres at offsite campuses of the University at Baderwah and Kathua handed over to the government :
 - 460 beds facility at Kathua Campus
 - 100 beds facility at Baderwah Campus
 - Real Time Polymerase Chain Reaction (PCR) machine; High Speed Refrigerated Centrifuge
 - Contribution of one day salary by the teaching and non-teaching employees
 - About 10,000 NSS volunteers of the University and its affiliated colleges, contributed actively in the fight against the pandemic
 - Adoption of a revised Academic Calendar
 - Faculty engaged in online classes
 - Submission of thesis, holding of viva voce of M.Phil and Ph.D scholars online

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- Remote access to e-resources; more than 1000 on-line journals; thousands e-books, video lectures
- Online platform for examination related issues; issuance of degrees and certificates
- Online admissions

The Vice Chancellor further apprised the University Council about future action plan for setting of following Centres:

2. Media Centre having following components:

1. Digital Lab
2. Oral History Cell
3. Community Radio
4. E-content Development

The council appreciated the efforts of the University for having taken quantum jump in NIRF ranking from 74 to 52 and congratulated the Vice Chancellor and his University colleagues for the improvement in the ranking.

- ii/ The Chancellor while chairing the maiden 86th University Council meeting of the University of Jammu asked both the Vice Chancellors of Jammu University and Kashmir University to put added efforts in tandem for promoting excellence in teaching, research, academics and extension and outreach activities. He advised to boost the academic research by uplifting the basic necessary work environment, updating e-learning and other teaching-learning tools and by providing the students with best educational resources and platforms, besides upgrading the infrastructural facilities in the Universities.
- iii/ The Chancellor stressed for conducting a comprehensive assessment of University's research activities for outlining its role in the welfare of civil society at large. He also emphasised for promotion of research outcomes aimed in solving local and regional problems of U.T of J&K and encouraging research scholars for the same.

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- iv/ The Chancellor stressed that literary work in two regional languages – Dogri in the University of Jammu and Kashmiri in the University of Kashmir be encouraged by setting up of Centres of Excellence in two respective Universities. The Chancellor directed that translation of existing work in the other languages of the country be also initiated for the promotion of culture, tradition and heritage of U.T of J&K at National and International level. He also urged that both the Universities should explore the possibilities to work on the other local languages of U.T of J&K such as Pahari, Gojari etc. for the promotion of cultural and multi-linguistic heritage of the J&K.

Underlining the importance of overall development of student community, the Chancellor advised for increased participation of students in co-curricular activities like NSS, NCC, sports, music etc., and students be encouraged to participate in social activities.

- v/ The Chancellor observed that the best teaching and learning methods should be adopted along with regular capacity building and orientation of teaching faculties of the University. He laid stress on developing a curriculum based on student's feedback by counting it as a globally accepted practice which lend a different perspective to the existing pedagogy.
- vi/ While discussing the issue of reservation, the Chancellor directed that modalities for extending the benefits of reservation policy in all the Universities across the U.T of J&K be worked out and finalised in mission mode.
- vii/ The Chancellor urged for the establishment of research and incubation centres in the Universities and underscored that higher education institutions without them are incomplete.
- viii/ The Chancellor hailed the New Education Policy (NEP) and said it will empower the youth towards nation-building. He stressed that under this policy critical thinking shall be encouraged in addition to development of skills and hands-on-learning. He further stressed that special focus be given to accessibility, equality, quality, affordability and accountability in education sector.
- ix/ While convening the meeting, the Chancellor directed that the academic and administrative matters be dealt in academic council and University Syndicate, respectively and only policy decision matters should be presented in the University council in future.
- x/ Arising out of the discussion, it was brought to the kind notice of Hon'ble Chancellor that there is a long pending issue of enhancement of retirement age of Teaching faculty of the Universities of the UT of J&K from present 62 years to 65 years as per UGC Regulations. The Hon'ble Chancellor directed that a committee under the chairmanship of Advisor to Hon'ble Lt. Governor shall examine the whole issue and submit its recommendations for the approval of the Hon'ble Chancellor.

ITEM NO. 86.22

Considered the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having authorized implementation of 10% reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admission to the various programmes offered in the University of Jammu from the Academic Session 2019-20 as per the criteria as under:

1. There shall be a reservation in all the programmes/courses offered by the University for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) of society, who are not covered under the existing scheme of reservation for the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Socially and Educationally Backward Classes etc.
2. The reservation would be in addition to the existing reservation and subject to a maximum of 10% of the prescribed in-take capacity in each programme/course.
3. These seats (EWSs) shall not be convertible i.e. if the seat/s under this category remains vacant in any programme, it shall not be converted to Open or any other Category.
4. The definition of Economically Weaker Sections shall be such as may be notified by the State from time to time on the basis of family income and other indicators of economic disadvantage.

RESOLVED that the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having authorized implementation of 10% reservation for the Economically Weaker Sections (EWSs) for admission to the various programmes offered in the University of Jammu from the Academic Session 2019-20 as per the abovementioned criteria, be ratified.






