# Sport Policy of University of Jammu

## Background

As Sports is now a compulsory component according to National Education Policy. The Hon'ble Prime Minister of India Shri Narendra Modi initiated various programmes in Sports- Khelo India Games, Drug Free India, Promoting Sports, Promoting Sports among females, Fit India campaign, etc in order to make India strong physically as well. Equal opportunity is given to the female sportsperson also. To attract the students towards sports and to make career opportunities in sports, the University of Jammu is going to make SPORTS POLICY that will surely benefitted the outstanding sportsperson/s.

**Part (a)** Relaxation in Admission fee and Hostel Accommodation for outstanding sportsperson/s who have different level of participation in sports. Free accommodation (over and above routine quota of the Directorate /Department) shall be provided to all the sportsperson/s and 100%, 50% & 25% relaxation in Admission fee for those outstanding sportsperson/s who have won medals at different levels as mentioned below:

- The Games/ Sports/ Events in which the Outstanding Sportspersons participated must be recognized by AIU (Association of Indian Universities), I.O.A, I.O.C, B.C.C.I and concerned Sports Federations.

b) The candidate taking admission under Outstanding Sportsmen Category will get only Free Accommodation in the Hostel. rest all expenses shall be made by the candidate (Food, personal expenses, etc).

**Part (b)** Relaxation in Attendance from the start of the coaching camp till the completion of the Competition/Tournament/Championship must be given to the outstanding sportsperson/s who participated at different levels on the recommendation of the Admission committee of the Directorate of Sports and Physical Education only if the player fulfils the conditions as mentioned below:

**Note:**

a) The Games/ Sports/ Events in which the Outstanding Sportspersons participated must be recognized by AIU (Association of Indian Universities), I.O.A, I.O.C, B.C.C.I and concerned Sports Federations.

b) If a candidate is going to participate in the Games/ Sports/ Events at different levels in that academic year i.e. both semesters, he/she has to apply for the permission from Director, Directorate of Sports and Physical Education, University of Jammu for participation in that event.

c) If a candidate has participated in the Games/ Sports/ Events at different levels in that academic year i.e. both semesters, he/she has to move an application along with documentary evidence to the concerned authority to avail relaxation in attendance.

d) The relaxation in attendance shall have an upper limit of no more than 45 days in the entire academic year (i.e. both semesters).

**Part (c)** Awarding grace marks to all the outstanding sportsperson/s who participated at different levels of competitions. Upto **18 marks** per subject shall be awarded to the outstanding sportsperson/s who have different levels of participation and achievements by following the conditions as per the given table.

The detail of the grace marks to be awarded is as under:

a) The Games/ Sports/ Events in which the Outstanding Sportspersons participated must be recognized by AIU (Association of Indian Universities), I.O.A. I.O.C. B.C.C.I and concerned Sports Federations.

b) The grace marks shall be awarded to the students for passing purpose only.

**Conditions:**

1. Grace marks shall be awarded to the students only if he/she is applying for the same.
2. The above mentioned grace marks can be applied to pass one or more than one subjects where ever it is required to the student in that academic year i.e. both semesters.
3. Grace marks shall be awarded to the students only if he/she has participated at different levels in that academic year i.e. both semesters.
4. If a student has participated in the Games/ Sports/ Events at different levels in that academic year i.e. both semesters, he/she has to move an application along with documentary evidence to the concerned authority to avail grace marks.
5. If the student achieved medals in more than one game/ sport, only best/ highest achievement will be considered.

Part (d) To provide incentives/cash awards to the outstanding sportsperson/s who represented University of Jammu teams in Inter-University events/ outstanding sportsperson/s of P.G courses of the University of Jammu who have different levels of participation in order to encourage them. The incentives/cash awards shall be given according to the levels of participation and achievements of the players as per given table. Minimum Rs 8000 and Maximum Rs 1 lakh shall be awarded to the outstanding sportsperson/s as mentioned in following table.

**Part (e)** To provide scholarship to the outstanding sportsperson/s of P.G courses of the University of Jammu who have different levels of participation on monthly basis in order to meet their basic dietary requirements for particular sports. Maximum Rs 7500/- per month and Minimum Rs 1000/- as scholarship shall be provided to the outstanding sportsperson/s of P.G courses as per table.

The detail of the proposed scholarships to be provided is as under:

**Terms and Conditions:**

1. The Games/ Sports/ Events in which the student participated must be recognized by AIU (Association of Indian Universities), I.O.A, I.O.C, B.C.C.I and concerned Sports Federations.
2. Scholarship shall be provided to the sportspersons only if he/she is applying for the same along with documentary evidence verified through the Directorate of Sports and Physical Education, University of Jammu, Jammu.
3. The scholarship shall be provided to the students only for one highest achievement.
4. The student shall be eligible for the scholarship till he/she is enrolled (bonafide student) with the University of Jammu (Maximum 2 years).

**Part (f)** To enhance D.A and refreshment of players students and officials (Coach/Manager/Asstt Coach/Teacher In-charge) accompanying them for participation in competitions/ Tournaments /Camps/Educational Tours with in the state or out of the state. The existing (from 2015 onwards till now) and proposed rates are mentioned in the below table.
