- 1. No candidate shall be admitted to the Entrance Test venue without Admit Card.
- 2. Candidates are advised to come well in advance to verify the details given in the list and report any discrepancy to the office before the commencement of the test.

SYLLABI, MODALITIES AND OTHER REQUIREMENTS OF THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION FOR LL.M. 2 YEAR REGULAR COURSE, SESSION 2020-21.

- 1. Subject to the eligibility requirements under the existing Statutes governing LL.M. (55% marks in qualifying degree 50% marks in case of SC & ST candidates), the eligible candidates shall apply to appear in Entrance Examination to be conducted by the Department of Law.
- 2. The Entrance Test shall be of three hours duration. It shall be subjective in nature and carry 100 marks. The question paper shall comprise of fifteen questions of which the candidate shall be required to attempt any ten questions (not more than 200 words per question). In order to qualify the entrance examination, the candidates shall be required to secure minimum of 50 marks.
- 3. The candidates who have qualified LL.B. 3 years or LL.B. 5 years from a University other than the University of Jammu should have obtained 60% marks in the qualifying examination.
- 4. The syllabi for the entrance examination shall be as per the syllabus prescribed for LL.B. Course and shall comprise of the following subjects:
 - i. Jurisprudence
 - ii. Constitutional Law of India.
 - iii. International Law and Human Rights
 - iv. Family Law (Hindu Law/Muslim Law)
 - v. Criminal Law (IPC/Cr PC/Evidence)
 - vi. Administrative Law
 - vii. Commercial Law (Company Law, Contract, Partnership)
- 5. The merit of the candidates shall be calculated on the basis of 25% weightage to the entrance test and 75% weightage to the academic merit of the candidate in the qualifying degree.
- 6. The entrance test shall be held on 28th June 2021 (Monday) at 10.00 a.m. in the Department of Law.
