University of Jammu:

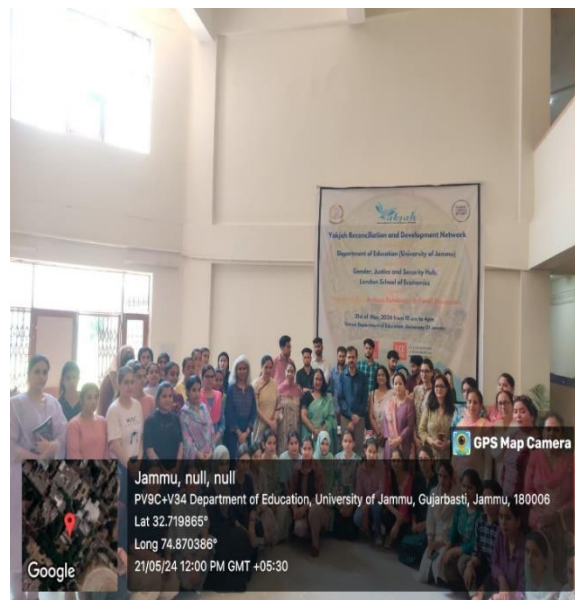
The University of Jammu came into existence in 1969 vide Kashmir and Jammu Universities Act 1969 following bifurcation of the erstwhile University of Jammu and Kashmir. The University is accredited as 'A+' grade with CGPA 3.51 by National Assessment & Accreditation Council (NAAC) in 2016. University of Jammu is ranked 63rd among top 100 universities of India as per National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) Report 2023.



About the Department

The Department of Education was established in the year 1973. The Department started M.Ed. class of one year with an intake of 25 students along with one professor and four lecturers to cater to the needs of the students in sharing the teaching responsibility. Later, another class of M.A. Education, two-year course was started in the year 1978 with an intake capacity of 50 students. This class was started to build up a logical continuity for large number of the students passing education as a subject at B.A. level. The Department is presently

housed in a building which is shared with Department of Sociology, and enjoys the privilege of Faculty of two Departments, i.e., Department of Education and Directorate of Sports and Physical Education. Prof. Rajeev Rattan Sharma is the Dean, Faculty of Education and Prof. (Dr.) Renu Nanda is the Head, Department of Education. There are three Assistant Professors and five contractual Lecturers in the Department. The Department has distinguished features as it focuses on experiential and project-based learning through initiatives like Vidyanjali, Learners' Ability Management Programme (LAMP), lab-to-land and land-to-lab experiences, creation of nature club, establishment of Book-Bank, etc. The Department is currently running M.A. Education, M.Ed. and Ph.D. programmes and hence the second largest Department of University of Jammu.

- On receiving the acceptance, submit the full paper before **05-06-2024**.

- The full paper must be an original submission not presented or published elsewhere.
- The author(s) should indicate his/her personal full contact details.

Layout of the Abstract and Full Paper:

- **Author(s):** Provide Author's name, institution, email and contact details.
- **Abstract:** Suitable title within 250-300 words, 3 to 5 keywords, problem specification, methodology and findings of the study.
 - **Note:** Rename the MS-Word document of abstract by the name of the presenter/s.
- **Full Paper:** Full paper should be written within 4500–5000-word limit indicating problem of the study, review of related literature, objectives, methodology, findings of the study, educational implications, suggestions followed by references.
- **Text:** Times New Roman with 12 Font size
- **Referencing Style:** APA 7th Edition.
