**Allotment of Open Elective Courses (4<sup>th</sup> Semester- Academic Session 2021-22)**

Online Applications are invited from the students for Admission to the various Open Elective Courses offered by the various Teaching Departments of the University of Jammu in the 4<sup>th</sup> Semester for the Academic Session 2021-22.

**Important Information for all concerned:**

- 1) In addition to the core/elective courses, a student (MDP-CBCS) shall be required to opt for one course of his/her choice as Open Elective from any other programme in 4<sup>th</sup> Semester.
- 2) The allotment of the Open Choice Course in 4<sup>th</sup> Semesters is made on the basis of the merit of 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> Semesters and the preferences of the Applicant/s given in the application form, as the case may be. In case of a tie, the admission shall be made on the basis of the Under Graduate result.
- 3) The list of Open Choice Courses to be offered by the various Teaching Departments of the University in 4<sup>th</sup> Semester for the Academic Session 2021-22 is enclosed herewith.

All Heads/Directors of the Teaching Departments shall ensure that all the students of their Department get themselves admitted in the concerned Department (**through the teacher in-charge of that Open Elective Course**) within the prescribed dates as notified.
- 7) After Admissions are made, the Department/s offering Open Elective Course shall furnish a complete list and detail of the students admitted in their Department with full particulars (like Name, Parentage, Parent Department, Roll No., Name of the Open Course allotted etc.) to the office of the Dean Academic Affairs; Controller of Examinations & to the Head of the concerned/Parent Department of the Students for information and further necessary action, as required.
