It is hereby notified for the information of all the candidates under non-exempted category who have applied for enrolment to Ph.D in Law that they have to appear in the Entrance Test, the date of which shall be notified separately by the Department of Law, University of Jammu. The entrance test shall be comprised of following parts:

PART-A RESEARCH APTITUDE (5X10=50 Marks)


This component shall be descriptive in nature, consist of 8 questions. The candidates shall be required to attempt any 5 questions and the answer to each question shall not exceed 300 words. Each question shall carry 10 marks.

PART-B ACADEMIC COMPONENT (50X1= 50 Marks)

This component shall consist of 50 multiple choice objective type questions (with four alternative responses) covering the following syllabi at the LL.B Course of the Department namely, (i) International Law (ii) Constitutional & Administrative Law (iii) Family Law (iv) Criminal Law (v) Human Rights and Humanitarian Law (vi) Environmental Law (vii) Jurisprudence.

The merit list of the candidates shall be calculated as per criteria given below:-

- (i) Academic weightage-50% of the marks obtained by a candidate at the post-graduate level.
- (ii) Entrance Test weightage-50% of the marks obtained by a candidate in the entrance test conducted by the Department. A candidate shall be required to secure at least 50% marks in the Entrance Test in aggregate and in each component separately.
- (iii) Interview- for allotment of the Supervisor of the selected candidates.
