The entrance test shall be comprised of following parts:

Part-A RESEARCH METHODOLOGY (5x10=50 Marks)

This component shall be descriptive in nature, consist of 8 questions. The candidate shall be required to attempt any 5 questions and the answer to each question shall not exceed 300 words. Each question shall carry 10 marks.

Part- B ACADEMIC COMPONENT (50x1=50 Marks)

This component shall consist of 50 multiple choice objective type questions (with four alternative responses). Each question shall carry one mark and candidate shall attempt all the 50 questions of this component.

The syllabus shall consist of (i) International Law (ii) Constitutional Law (iii) Administrative Law (iv) Family Law (v) Criminal Law (vi) Human Rights and Humanitarian Law (vii) Environment Law (viii) Jurisprudence.

The merit list of the candidates shall be calculated as per criteria given below:-

- (i) Academic weightage -50% of the marks obtained by a candidate in LL.M.
- (ii) Entrance test weightage -50% of the marks obtained by a candidate in the entrance test conducted by the Department. A candidate shall be required to secure at least 50% marks in the entrance test in aggregate and in each component separately.
- (iii) Interview for allotment of the Supervisor of the selected candidates.
