INITIATIVE

The University of Jammu and High Altitude Warfare School (HAWS) of Army at Gulmarg have entered into a MoU for technical advancement and progression of Army personnel and university students and faculty members specifically in the discipline of high altitude studies and disaster management in mountainous regions. Under this MOU the Disaster Management Centre (DMC) of the Geology Department has formulated three skill based certificate courses in Disaster Management on rock craft and mountain rescue; Search, rescue and survival; Snow craft and avalanche rescue for the students to be run by the DMC in collaboration with HAWS.

Applications are invited for admission to **three months** Certificate Course in Disaster Management on **“Rock Craft and Mountain Rescue”** being run at University of Jammu in collaboration with High Altitude Warfare School (HAWS), Gulmarg. The course will aid in developing the skills of learners to get self-employment by planning different adventure sports and camps and also help to enhance the unexplored adventure sports of the Jammu region. The training of local youth and volunteer students by the instructors of HAWS in their training centres in Kashmir shall help in imparting special skills to the students and developing trained manpower for rescue work during an eventuality.

This certificate course has two components theory and practical training. The theory component and basic training shall be conducted in the University of Jammu and advance practical training for 10 to 15 days shall be conducted by the HAWS instructors at their training centers in Kashmir.

Eligibility:

- i) Candidate must have passed 10+2 examination
- ii) Candidate at the time of application should not have age more than 32 years
- iii) Admission will be made on the basis of academic merit
- iv) Fitness certificate from Government Hospital is must

Fee: Total Fee for the entire course is Rs. 20000/- which includes the expenses for practical training at HAWS training centres in Kashmir.

Total Seats: 30 (20% seats are reserved for in-service candidates)
