CIRCULAR

Guidelines for Managing Stray Dogs on Campus

The following guidelines are issued for strict compliance by all campus inhabitants, with particular emphasis on supporting staff such as Chowkidars:

1. **Refrain from Feeding Stray Dogs:** Do not offer food, water, or other items to stray dogs within departmental buildings, lawns, pathways, or the immediate vicinity of academic/administrative areas. Feeding inadvertently encourages congregation during working hours, leading to territorial behaviours that may result in conflicts or bites.
2. **Maintain a Safe Distance:** Do not approach, tease, or provoke stray dogs to avoid potential aggressive responses.
3. **Report Incidents Immediately:** In case of aggressive behaviour, bites, or injuries caused by stray dogs, immediately report to the University Health Centre for first aid and medical treatment or proceed directly to the Anti-Rabies Section of GMC Jammu.
4. **Non-Emergency Reporting:** For sightings of large groups of stray dogs or distressed animals, inform the Security Office for coordinated handling of the situation.
5. **Proper Waste Management:** Ensure waste bins are securely covered to prevent attracting stray dogs, thereby reducing nuisance and health hazards.

Your cooperation in adhering to these guidelines is highly solicited to ensure a safe and harmonious campus environment for all.
