Re:- Introduction of Free Homeopathic OPD Services for Employees, Students, and Scholars of the University under MoU with Government Homeopathy Medical College, Kathua

In a significant step towards enhancing the healthcare facilities at the University Health Centre, the University of Jammu is pleased to announce the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Government Homeopathy Medical College, Kathua. This collaboration aims to provide accessible and affordable homeopathic healthcare Services to the University fraternity.

## Salient Features of the New OPD Initiative:

- 1. Services Offered: Homeopathic consultation and free medicines for all the beneficiaries.
- 2. Applicability: Available to all University employees, students, and scholars.
- 3. Nominal Fee: OPD slip charges of Rs. 20/- only for the employees (valid for 15 days). Students and Scholars of the University shall not be required to pay any fee.
- 4. Free Medicines: Free Homeopathy medicines shall be provided by the University Health Centre
- 5. Schedule: OPD services will be conducted once a week, every Thursday, at the University Health Centre (from 10:00 a.m. to 05:00 p.m.).

Further, the University has also scheduled a seminar on 11<sup>th</sup> December 2025 from 11:00 AM to 1:00 PM at Brigadier Rajinder Singh Auditorium (BRSA) for the awareness of students, scholars and employees about the homeopathic treatment.

All are cordially invited to attend the seminar to gain insights into the benefits and applications of homeopathy treatment.

This initiative is designed to promote holistic wellness and ensure timely medical support for the ailments through the time-tested benefits of homeopathy. All beneficiaries are encouraged to utilize these services for preventive and curative care.
