



MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY Condition for PG PROGRAMMES

A candidate seeking admission to the M.Sc. Remote Sensing and GIS programme must have passed/appeared in the final semester of Bachelor's Degree with Major/ Core course in Science subject or BCA, Engineering, Agriculture, Forestry, or Bachelor's Degree in Arts with Geography as a Major/ minor subject, from a recognized Indian University with minimum 50% marks, OR have earned 50% credits in the above subjects under UG programme as per NEP-2020, are eligible.

ORDER OF PREFERENCES

FIRST PREFERENCE (CUET & Major Subject)	CUET-PG-2026 + Programme Specific Eligibility. NOTE: To be eligible for admission applicant must have scored minimum 40 Marks in a particular paper of CUET-PG-2026
SECOND PREFERENCE (JUET & Major Subject)	For 2 Years PG Programme: Composite Merit comprising 70% of Academic Merit and 30% of JUET-2026 Score + Programme Specific Eligibility.
THIRD PREFERENCE (CUET & Minor Subject)	CUET-PG-2026 + Minimum 24 Credits in the MINOR Subject of the Qualifying Examination. NOTE: To be eligible for admission applicant must have scored minimum 40 Marks in a particular paper of CUET-PG-2026
FOURTH PREFERENCE (Non CUET & Non JUET)	Academic Merit of the qualifying examination.
