It is hereby notified for the information of all concerned that the Vice Chancellor, in anticipation of the approval of the Competent Bodies, has been pleased to authorize the amendments/incorporations in the following clauses of the Statutes governing One Year and Two Year Post Graduate Programmes as per National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 (Through Regular Mode):

<p>5.9</p> <p>A regular student who after having passed all the prescribed courses of I or II or III or IV semester examinations of degree programme discontinues his/her study for good and sufficient reasons to the satisfaction of the Head of the Department concerned, may be considered for admission to III or IV Semester of the course, as the case may be.</p> <p>PROVIDED that not more than one year has elapsed after his/her having passed I or II or III or IV Semester examination in the concerned programme of study. Such a break shall be allowed only once during a programme of study.</p> <p>PROVIDED further that such a student will have to opt courses which are prescribed for the session to which admission is being sought unless it leads to repetition of any course (s) of the programme of study.</p>	<p>5.9</p> <p>(a) A student shall be promoted from 2nd semester to 3rd semester, if he/she has earned 50% credits in Theory/ Practical Courses cumulatively in earlier semesters of the programme.</p> <p>(b) A regular student who after having passed all the prescribed courses of I or II or III or IV semester examinations of degree programme discontinues his/her study for good and sufficient reasons to the satisfaction of the Head of the Department concerned, may be considered for admission to III or IV Semester of the course, as the case may be.</p> <p>PROVIDED that not more than one year has elapsed after his/her having passed I or II or III or IV Semester examination in the concerned programme of study. Such a break shall be allowed only once during a programme of study.</p> <p>PROVIDED further that such a student will have to opt courses which are prescribed for the session to which admission is being sought unless it leads to repetition of any course (s) of the programme of study.</p>
<p>29. PERIOD OF STAY</p> <p>The Master's Degree of 1 and 2 Year has to be completed in a maximum of 3 to 5 years respectively. A candidate availing exit option shall have the option to re-enter the programme within 3 years of exit, at the beginning of any academic year, to complete the degree with the syllabi in vogue, however, with the condition that the total period of completion, including the period between exit and re-entry, shall not exceed 7 years.</p>	<p>29. PERIOD OF STAY</p> <p>The Master's Degree of 1 and 2 Year has to be completed in a maximum of 3 to 4 years respectively. A candidate availing exit option shall have the option to re-enter the programme within 3 years of exit, at the beginning of any academic year, to complete the degree with the syllabi in vogue, however, with the condition that the total period of completion, including the period between exit and re-entry, shall not exceed 7 years.</p>
