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

MAIN RURAL DEVELOPMENT


The DLL started a two years' regular Master's degree programme in Rural Development from August 2013. Students are admitted through JUET (Jammu University Entrance Test)

- To organise programmes of entrepreneurship.


Equal Opportunity Cell


During the session 2020-21, EIAB organised an online Career Counselling






