2. For point No. (i), (ii), (iii) & (iv), the Head of the Department in consultation with the concerned student shall have the option to decide the replacement of Major Course or Value Added Course, Skill Enhancement Course and Ability Enhancement Course as the case may be, in lieu of the credits earned in the Co-Curricular activity for UG/PG Programme & Replacement or additional Course. Further a candidate can earn maximum credits, subject to the conditions that not more than 4 credits are earned in a particular year.

4 credits in a year

8 credit in two years

12 credit in 3 years

16 credits in 4 years and

20 credits in 5 years

3. In case of students doing Internship as part of curricula, the credit distribution will be: -
- a) Internship Programmes of 4 weeks - 4 credit
 - b) Internship Programmes of 6 weeks - 6 credit
 - c) If the Internship Programmes is of 8 weeks or above that, the candidates will earn 8 credit
4. In case of students opting for practical learning like Industrial visits or field visit and also point No. 3, a letter be written to all Head of the Departments for deciding as to how to include it in curriculum in lieu of Major or other courses in consultation with their respective Board of Studies under an intimation to the Academic Section.

Note: In the event of any ambiguity, the decision of the Dean Academic Affairs with the approval of Competent Authority shall be final.
