Importance:

- Decoction of the bark has been used as ulcer wash, while bark ashes have been prescribed for snakebite and scorpion sting.
- Fresh leaf juice is used for the treatment of earache and bark powder for treating heart ailments.
- Its stem bark is acrid, sweet, cooling, styptic, tonic, antidysenteric and is febrifuge in nature.
