Background

Training school leaders for the contemporary world is essential as it equips them with the necessary skills to navigate and respond effectively to rapid changes in technology, societal norms, and education policies. More than ever, school leaders are called upon to cultivate inclusive environments, foster innovation, and leverage data-driven strategies to improve student outcomes. They are instrumental in shaping the school's culture and curriculum to reflect the globalized world and prepare students for future challenges and opportunities. Without such forwardthinking leadership, schools risk falling behind in providing education that is relevant, meaningful, and prepares students to thrive in the 21st century. In light of the above, this Management Development Programme seeks to train and develop contemporary leadership skills aligned to the changing needs of schools and the society at large.

Objectives of the MDP

Through this Programme, the school leaders principals would be able to:

 Learn about leadership through the lens of contemporary management and business strategies.

- Improve educational outcomes by understanding how to effectively manage change, fostering a climate conducive to high performance, and promoting these pillars of a high-performing institution.
- Use the tenets of good leadership to solve the problems encountered by principals/school managers/promoters.

Programme Content and Outline

The key deliberations and training shall revolve around four core areas including:

- Leadership for a Positive School Climate
- School Discipline & Emotional Regulation
- Leadership for Innovative Practices in Schools
- Driving Change through Gamification

Structure

The two-day programme shall be spread across four sessions daily and include a series of context specific case studies, role-plays, presentations, workshops and one-to-one interactions.

Athan Dushyant Shukla is an associate professor and chairperson at the Ravi J. Matthai Centre for Educational Innovation, Indian Institute of Management Ahmedabad. Recently, he has been involved with research, capacity building, and policy consultation with the states of Karnataka, Delhi, Punjab, and Gujarat.


