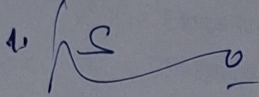

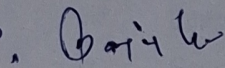
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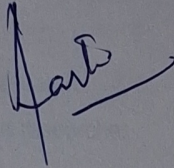

2. This paper shall be exempted to the candidates having Two years LL.M. Degree from University of Jammu. However, it shall be compulsory for all others having one year/two years LL.M

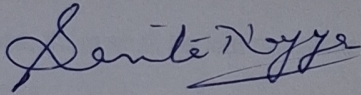
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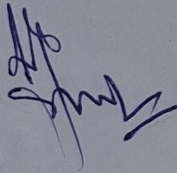
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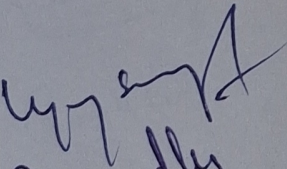
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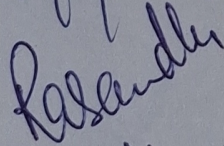
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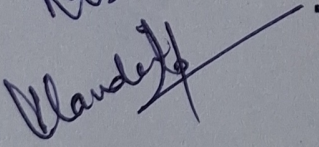


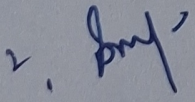


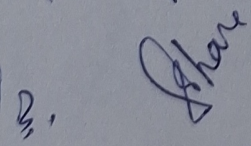


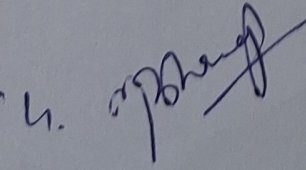


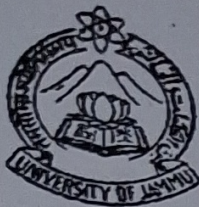




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Specialized Area of Research
