Contemporary trends in higher education clearly show that digital technologies have become an integral part of the system. However, there is a need to integrate or *Blend* digital technologies with higher education for effective learning and development of the educated and skilled youth, contributing for the development of *Atmanirbhar Bharat*.

Despite the impressive growth of higher education in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir, the critical issue of ensuring quality and inclusivity in blended learning practices emerges as a significant concern. The inertia of higher education institutions of J&K to adapt to changing paradigms manifests in the limited success of blended learning initiatives and the progress of the UT on this front.

Against this backdrop, this **Policy Dialogue** between eminent Policy Makers, Educationists, Representatives from Civil Societies, Faculty Members, and Researchers will highlight the multifaceted barriers obstructing the effective implementation of *blended learning in the higher education institutions of J&K*.

The Policy Dialogue, which is based on the Policy Brief, will offer implementable solutions based on empirical evidence and propose a series of *evidence-based recommendations* aimed at fostering the development of inclusive blended learning practices in the Colleges and Universities of J&K. The recommendations will pave the way for an excellent, equitable, accessible, and resilient higher education landscape in the UT and work as a building block for the nation to become a *Vishwaguru*.

The Policy Brief is based on ITLDE, a large-scale, empirical, multi-institutional, longitudinal study funded by IIT Jammu. The study collected data from more than 4700 students and 370 teachers from 25 higher education institutions across six districts of Jammu & Kashmir over three years.
