**It is for the information of all concerned that PG Department of Remote Sensing & GIS will conduct admission to the M.Sc Remote Sensing & GIS for the Academic Session 2026-28 as per details given below:**

A candidate seeking admission to the M.Sc. Remote Sensing and GIS programme must have passed/appeared in the final semester of Bachelor's Degree with Major/ Core course in Science subject or BCA, Engineering, Agriculture, Forestry, or Bachelor's Degree in Arts with Geography as a Major/ Core subject, from a recognized Indian University with minimum 50% marks, OR have earned 50% credits in the above subjects under UG programme as per NEP-2020, are eligible.

**FOR ADMISSION FOLLOWING WILL BE THE ORDER OF PREFERENCE:**

<b>FIRST PREFERENCE (CUET &amp; Major Subject)</b>	CUET-PG-2026 + Programme Specific Eligibility. <b>NOTE: To be eligible for admission applicant must have scored minimum 40 Marks in a particular paper of CUET-PG-2026</b>
<b>SECOND PREFERENCE (JUET &amp; Major Subject)</b>	<b>For 2 Years PG Programme:</b> Composite Merit comprising 70% of Academic Merit and 30% of JUET-2026 Score + Programme Specific Eligibility. <b>For 1 Year PG Programme:</b> Composite Merit comprising 50% of Academic Merit and 50% of JUET-2026 Score + Programme Specific Eligibility
<b>THIRD PREFERENCE (CUET &amp; Minor Subject)</b>	CUET-PG-2026 + Minimum 24 Credits in the MINOR Subject of the Qualifying Examination. <b>NOTE: To be eligible for admission applicant must have scored minimum 40 Marks in a particular paper of CUET-PG-2026</b>
<b>FOURTH PREFERENCE (Non CUET &amp; Non JUET)</b>	Academic Merit of the qualifying examination.

Under First Preference CUET-PG-2026 Score in Science subjects, including Botany, Zoology, Geography, Geology, Environmental Science, Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, Statistics, Computer Science, Biotechnology, Microbiology, Atmospheric Science, Soil Science, and relevant Engineering disciplines shall be considered for admission.

Candidates appearing in JUET-2026 will be considered under 2<sup>nd</sup> Preference.
