## PG ADMISSION NOTIFICATION - 03

REVISED ELIGIBILITY FOR ONLINE REGISTRATION FOR ADMISSION TO THE VARIOUS POST GRADUATE PROGRAMMES (ACADEMIC SESSION 2024-25)

It is for the information of all concerned that any applicant who has appeared in the Common University Entrance Test (CUET-PG-2024) conducted by the National Testing Agency (NTA) can apply for admission to the various PG Programmes of the University of Jammul Offsite Campuses/ Affiliated Colleges for the Academic Session (2024-25).

Previous condition of clearance of first five semesters for Online Registration is withdrawn and now any applicant who has appeared in the CUET-PG-2024 can apply for admission WITH THE CONDITION that only those applicants will be allotted seats for admission who have passed the first 5 Semesters of the qualifying Bachelor's Degree Examination (Honours or Generally 6 Semesters of B Tech. 8 Semester of LL B (5 Yrs), 3 Semesters of B, Ed/B, P, Ed (for M, Ed/M, P, Ed), 1 Semester of B, Lib I, Sc (for M, Lib.) OR who has qualified examination of a professional degree of not less than 3 years duration OR any other examination recognised sequivalent thereof, from a recognised university/institution with at-least 50% of the aggregate marks (45% for the SC/ST candidates) as on date of allocation of seats.

## IMPORTANT NOTE:

- 1. NO AFFIDAVIT is required for Self-Undertaking. It can be submitted on a plain paper.
- 2. NO HARD COPY is required to be deposited in the University.
- Applicants after successful completion of registration of the online admission form are must keep print out of his/her Online Application and fee receipt for future reference.
