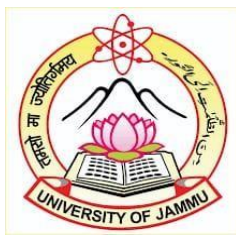

CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Abstracts not exceeding 500 words are invited on the sub-themes. The abstract must be typed in English Times New Roman with font size 12 and line spacing 1.5. The abstract should include Title, Name(s) of the author/co-author and organization, their address including e-mail and the Sub- theme. The name of the presenting author should be in bold. The abstract should be submitted electronically in 'MS Word file on the e-mail id: socioseminarju2026@gmail.com on or before 1st January, 2026.

Note: Selected papers will be published in an edited volume by a reputed publisher.

SUB-THEMES

- Caste, class, and gender inequalities in changing contexts.
- Conflict, Migration and Identity.
- Digital divide and access to knowledge in the information age.
- Environmental justice and climate vulnerability.
- Mental health, stigma, and social care.
- Open Panel (Issues other than those listed in the sub themes).

Communication of Abstract Acceptance:

The organizing committee will notify applicants of their abstract's acceptance status by 07th January, 2026. The Committee's decision regarding selection of papers for presentation shall be final.

Full Paper Submission:

Authors whose abstracts are accepted must submit their complete papers by 20th January, 2026.

The delegates are requested to register themselves in advance. The Registration form is to be sent through email in PDF format along with the abstract in MS Word format latest by 1st January, 2026. The registration fee includes access to all sessions, seminar kit, working lunch and tea.
