## **Background**

The National Education Policy (NEP) 2020 envisions holistic education for learners, and strives to develop well-rounded, competent individuals with 21st-century skills. It emphasizes the capacity building of academicians as the most important factor ensuring the quality and engagement of faculty at higher education institutions. This brings attention to the role the teachers' pedagogical knowledge, experiences, and professional identity have in shaping the learning outcomes of their students. In view of this, it is necessary for the teachers to reshape their orientation towards teaching, improve their pedagogies to make them more interactive and student-centric and make classrooms inclusive spaces for not just reading but learning. The use of appropriate pedagogies is essential to ensure teaching effectiveness.

Henceforth, the capacity building of all faculty members and teachers in terms of knowledge enrichment, developing critical competence, creating learning resources, using digital technologies etc. are required for improving teaching and learning effectiveness using various innovative pedagogical approaches.

## Objectives of the Capacity Building Programme (CBP)

Given the significance of innovative pedagogy as an essential step toward effective teaching-learning, the CBP intends to:

 Impart innovative pedagogy-related training and skill building of the participants;

- Train the participants to engage through cases & plan case-based courses;
- Build participants' competency to develop & write cases;
- Integrating AI and Gamification in higher education teaching and learning processes;
- Facilitate hands-on experience and practical insights in emerging technologies.

## **Programme Content and Outline**

The key deliberations and hands-on sessions shall revolve around the following themes:

- InnovativeTeachingStrategies
- Essentials of Case Teaching
- Essentials of Case Writing
- Artificial Intelligence (AI)
- Gamification
- Research as Pedagogy

#### Structure

The 5-day programme shall be spread across three sessions daily and include a series of context specific case studies, role-plays, presentations, workshops and one-to-one interactions and peer learning.
