(REVISED SCHEDULE/ GUIDELINES for 2nd Round of Mid Entry Admissions for CUET & NON-CUET applicants)

In continuation to PG Admission Notification-13, the SCHEDULE for the Allocation of seats/ Physical Verification & Admissions for the **2**nd **Round of MID ENTRY ADMISSION (for vacant seats only) for CUET & NON-CUET applicants** is hereby REVISED as below:

2.	Onetime EDIT OPTION extended to all the applicants to make any correction/s or upload any left out documents in their online Application forms. No request/s for any correction shall be entertained thereafter.	09/07/2024
3.	LAST DATE for RE-UPLOADING of all the Semesters Marks Sheet of the qualifying examination for the NON-CUET applicants.	13-07-202 4
4.	Online ACCEPTANCE of the applications by the Department/ Nodal Departments	14/0 <mark>7/2024 & 15/07/20</mark> 24
5.	Declaration of 5 th ALLOCATION LIST (CUET & Non-CUET) in order of preference (i.e. 1 st Preference to CUET-PG-2024 and 2 nd to Non CUET) for all vacant seats including Self-Finance	17-07-2024
6.	Candidates to "FREEZE" the Allocated Department/ Campus/ College from his/her Account	17-07-2024 to 19-07-2024 (Upto 04:00 pm)

IMPORTANT GUIDELINES FOR ADMISSIONS UNDER 2ND ROUND OF MID ENTRY:

- 1. All applicants, who have applied under NON-CUET, need to UPLOAD mark-sheets of all the semesters of the qualifying examination. Any applicant who fails to do so within specified time or fails to fulfil the basic eligibility of 50% of the aggregate marks (45% for the SC/ST candidates) in the qualifying examination, shall be rejected.
- 2. However, CUET applicants shall be considered for PROVISIONAL admission if they have passed the first 5 Semesters of the qualifying Bachelor's Degree Examination (Honours or General)/ 6 Semesters of B.Tech, 8 Semester of LL.B (5 Yrs), 1 Semester of B.Lib.I.Sc (for M.Lib.) OR who has qualified examination of a professional degree of not less than 3 years duration OR any other examination recognised as equivalent thereof, from a recognised university/institution with at-least 50% of the aggregate marks (45% for the SC/ST candidates) as on date of allocation of seats
- **3.** The candidates, who have already been admitted in any of the programmes in the previous rounds of allocation, shall **not be eligible** for the 2nd Round of Mid-Entry Admission.
- **4.** All the candidates, who have already filled online admission form and not admitted in any of the previous allocated lists and have <u>applied afresh</u>, <u>shall also be considered for 2nd Round of Mid Entry on the basis of fresh preferences</u>.
- 5. The CUET-PG-2024 applicants will be given first preference for admission and the Non-CUET applicants will be considered under second preference.
- **6.** CUET-PG-2024 applicants will be allocated seats on the basis of CUET-PG-2024 score whereas the Non-CUET applicants will be allocated seats on the basis of the academic merit of their qualifying examination.

- 7. A candidate who applies in the 2nd Round of Mid-Entry will not hold any right to claim the seats allocated to candidates, who had applied to CSAS-PG-2024 during the initial rounds of allocation. Allocation of seats to such candidates may be considered subject to fulfillment of eligibility criteria, availability of seats, and other CSAS-PG-2024 rules.
- 8. Once the seat has been allocated to the candidate, it will be mandatory for him/her to take admission on the allocated seat. Failure to accept (FREEZE) the allocated seat will forfeit the candidate's right to seek admission to the course. The seat allocated in Mid Entry allocation round will be final and will not be upgraded.
- 9. Mid-Entry will only be considered after successful remittance of the Mid-Entry fee. Merely applying through Mid-Entry does not guarantee a seat.
- 10. In the Mid Entry, the allocation will be done on the basis of following Criteria.
 - i) Availability of Seats in a particular Programme/ Campus

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- ii) Program Specific Merit
- iii) Order of Preference of Deptts/ Campus/ College
- iv) Category.
- v) Any other allocation rules, policies or criteria mentioned in the notified guidelines on the admission website.
- 11. Once the candidates are provisionally admitted/accepted for admission, the admitted candidates will be required to Visit the Allocated Department/ Nodal Department for physical verification of the original documents.
- 12. The candidates will be considered admitted only after successful remittance of the requisite admission /Self Finance fees.
