IT IS FOR THE INFORMATION OF ALL CONCERNED THAT UNIVERSITY IS GOING TO CONDUCT JAMMU UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE TEST (JUET-2026) FOR ADMISSION TO THE FOLLOWING UG-PG PROGRAMMES OF THE UNIVERSITY OF JAMMU AT MAIN CAMPUS/ OFFSITE CAMPUSES AND AFFILIATED COLLEGES FOR THE ACADEMIC SESSION 2026-27:

1. Programmes Offered for admission for the Academic Session 2026-27 under JUET-PG:

- c) **One Year Post Graduate Programmes:** Dogri, English, Hindi, Punjabi, Sanskrit, Urdu, Commerce, Education, Biotechnology, Environmental Sciences, Botany, Zoology, Statistics, Mathematics, Chemistry, Geography, Home Science(Human Dev.), Applied Geology, Physics, Electronics, History, Economics, Political Science, Sociology, Psychology, Philosophy, M.Lib.I.Sc and any other.
- d) **Post Graduate Diploma Programmes:** PG Diploma in Human Rights & Duties Education, PG Diploma in Composite Culture Management, PG Diploma in Yoga, PG Diploma in Museology & Conservation and PG Diploma in Computer Applications (PGDCA) (Kishtwar Campus only), and any other.

2. Programmes Offered for admission for the Academic Session 2026-27 under JUET-UG:

- a) **Four Year Under Graduate Programmes:** B.Com. (Bhaderwah & Udhampur Campus); BBA (Hotel Management); BBA, BCA (Data Science) (Bhaderwah & Kathua Campus); B.A English (Kathua Campus only), and any other.
- b) **Four Year Bachelor of Physical Education & Sports (B.P.E.S) Program**

- e) **Five Year Integrated Programme in Law (B.A. LL.B Professional)**

3. FOR ADMISSION, FOLLOWING WILL BE THE MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY & ORDER OF PREFERENCES:

- a) **MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO ALL PG PROGRAMMES (EXCEPT LL.B):** The applicant must have passed the qualifying examination with minimum 50% marks aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination as per the Program-Specific Eligibility. In case of SC/ST the minimum eligibility is 45% marks in aggregate or equivalent grade. **For LL.B the candidate must have 45% of marks aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination for general category and 40% for SC/ST.**
- b) **MINIMUM ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION TO ALL UG PROGRAMMES (EXCEPT LAW):** The applicant must have passed the qualifying examination with minimum 50% marks aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination. In case of SC/ST the minimum eligibility is 45%. **For LL.B (5 Years) the candidate must have 45% of marks aggregate or equivalent grade in the qualifying examination for general category and 40% for SC/ST.**

FIRST PREFERENCE for UG (Composite Score of GAT + English Language of CUET-UG)	Composite Score obtained in the General Aptitude Test + English Language paper of CUET-UG-2026. <i>NOTE: To be eligible for admission applicant must have scored minimum 40 Marks in a particular paper/s of CUET-UG-2026</i>
SECOND PREFERENCE (JUET-2026)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) For 2 Years PG Programme: Composite Merit comprising 70% of Academic Merit and 30% of JUET-PG-2026 Score + Programme Specific Eligibility. b) For 1 Year PG Programme: Composite Merit comprising 50% of Academic Merit and 50% of JUET-PG-2026 Score + Programme Specific Eligibility c) For Integrated UG-PG/UG Programme: Composite Merit comprising 70% of Academic Merit and 30% of JUET-UG-2026 Score

NOTE: Provisional admission to Two /One Year PG Programme shall be made on the basis of the qualifying examination upto Semester 5th / 7th as the case may be. However, provisional admission to a particular programme shall be confirmed after passing of the 6th / 8th Semester of UG programme.

ABOUT JAMMU UNIVERSITY ENTRANCE TEST (JUET-2026)

- To register for JUET visit the University Website(JU Admissions-2026): <https://jammuuniversity.ac.in/PG/2026-27>
- There shall be separate set of JUET Question Papers i.e. one for the JUET-UG for the applicants appearing after 10+2 for UG Programmes and other JUET-PG for the applicants appearing after 10+2+3 or 10+2+4 for PG Two Years and One Year Programme of the University of Jammu, Main Campus and Offsite Campuses.
- Each set of JUET question papers (UG or PG) will have 150 multiple-choice questions (MCQ) with four options for a correct answer. Each question carries one mark and there will be no negative marking for incorrect answer. The duration of the JUET will be of 2½ hours.
- The contents of the JUET Paper shall be as under:**

1) General English-	40 questions	3) Reasoning-	40 questions
2) General Knowledge-	40 questions	4) Numerical Ability -	30 questions
- The **level of difficulty** of questions for numerical ability shall be of 10th standard for both UG/PG Question Paper. The level of questions for other components shall be of 12th standard for JUET-UG and Graduation standard for the candidates appearing for JUET-PG.
- Centres for Examinations:** JUET shall be conducted at the following Centres:

1) <i>Jammu</i>	4) <i>Kishtwar</i>	7) <i>Poonch</i>
2) <i>Kathua</i>	5) <i>Bhaderwah</i>	8) <i>Srinagar</i>
3) <i>Udhampur</i>	6) <i>Rajouri</i>	

NOTE: The applicants should give three choices, in order of preferences, for examination centres. However, the University holds the right not to conduct the examination in a particular centre if the number of students is less. The examination centre once opted by the candidate shall not be changed at any stage.
- FEE** for Jammu University Entrance Test (JUET-2026) to be charged from each candidate is **Rs.500/-** for all categories except SC/ST whereas the fee for SC/ST category is **Rs.450/-**. **MODE OF PAYMENT: Online (Net Banking/ Debit/ Credit Card/ UPI etc.).**
- Only one application form is to be submitted by a candidate. Under no circumstances, candidates will be allowed to fill more than one Application Form. Strict action will be taken, even at a later stage, against such candidates who would have filled more than one Application Form.
- Publication of ANSWER KEY:** The Answer Key shall be published on the next day of JUET Examination on the Website. The Link of same shall be integrated on the University official website at <https://jammuuniversity.ac.in/PG/2026-27>.
- Any candidate having any grievance with respect to Answer Key or Question/s of the JUET-2026, can lodge/register his/her challenge online on admission portal of the University with supporting documents/evidence along-with **non-refundable processing charges @ Rs. 200/- (Rupees two hundred only) per challenge/question as per the schedule notified.**
- The University shall provide **AMANUENSIS** to the **DIFFERENTLY ABLED**. However, the request in this regard has to be made to the Dean Academic Affairs, at least two weeks prior to the conduct of JUET-2026 and the amanuensis should have a lesser qualification than the candidate.
- Admission after declaration of Result:** The applicants who appear in CUET-2026 or JUET-2026 shall have to apply online for admission through the official site of the University. The detailed procedure for the same shall be notified after the declaration of JUET-2026 result.
