

Two lectures delivered during a **3- Day Multi Lingual workshop on writing “Andaaz- e- Nigaarish”** by Sh. Pritam Katoch from 9-11th of May 2023.

Lecture 1: Unraveling the Nuances of Good Writing

He addressed the significance of pacing in storytelling, advising attendees on when to speed up the narrative for dramatic effect and when to slow down for emphasis or character development.
