



**3.2 *ITEM NO. 2***

3.2.1 Considered the report about the action taken on the resolutions passed by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 26.05.2017.

3.2.2 **RESOLVED** that the report about the action taken on the resolutions passed by the Academic Council at its meeting held on 26.05.2017, **be confirmed.**

**3.3 *ITEM NO. 3***

3.3.1 Considered the matter regarding the admission of the students to the Under Graduate Courses under the Choice Based Credit System after the declaration of the re-evaluation result.

3.3.2 After threadbare discussion, it was **RESOLVED** as under:

- a) The decision with regard to the admission of students declared eligible after re-evaluation result be taken on case to case basis and the existing Statutes be not deviated.

- b) The Statute of re-evaluation as recommended for modification be considered to the extent that after the declaration of any Under Graduate result, 10 days be given to the students to apply for Photostat copy of the answer scripts under University Statutes by depositing the requisite prescribed fee. After the answer script/s is/are received by the candidate, he/she shall apply for re-evaluation within 10 days with normal fee and thereafter with late fee presently in vogue. The candidate/s who will not take the photostat copy of the answer script shall not be eligible to apply for re-evaluation.

### **3.4 ITEM NO. 4**

- 3.4.1 Considered the confirmation of the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor regarding the authorization of giving one special chance to the candidates to appear in the B.Ed. examination as private candidates as per the old B.Ed. examination scheme, as one time exception and the ones who were admitted in the M.A. Education programme prior to the issuance of the notification w.r.t. the adoption of the Statutes and the scheme for the two year B.Ed. course and the two year M.Ed. course vide No. F.Acd./1/15/3964-4163 dated 08.06.2015.

### **3.6 ITEM NO. 6**

- 3.6.1 Considered the confirmation of the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having authorized the following:
1. the eligibility of having passed in 50% of the papers for admission in Semester-V of B.A./B.SC./B.COM.(GENERAL)/BBA/BCA/Honours Course shall exclude Environmental Science paper of Semester-III;
  2. the eligibility for admission of students to Semester-III of the B.A./B.SC./B.COM.(GENERAL)/BBA/BCA/Honours Course under the Choice Based Credit System that stands fixed as having passed 50% of the credits, shall

be rounded off to the nearest lower side where 50% of the credits come to be an odd number and where no permutation/combination of subjects/papers makes it to that odd number of credits. For example, where a course is of 22 credits and 50% of credits is in odd number (11 credits), the eligibility shall be rounded off to 10 credits; and

3. the eligibility condition of having passed in the internal assessment in atleast 75% of the subjects/papers of Semester-II/IV of the B.A./B.SC./B.COM. (GENERAL)/BBA/BCA/Honours Course for admission to Semester-III & V respectively under the CBCS shall also be applicable to the Semester System students (Non-CBCS).

3.6.2 **RESOLVED** that the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having authorized the following i.e.:

1. the eligibility of having passed in 50% of the papers for admission in Semester-V of the B.A./B.SC./B.COM.(GENERAL)/BBA/BCA/Honours Course shall exclude Environmental Science paper of Semester-III;
2. the eligibility for admission of students to Semester-III of the B.A./B.SC./B.COM.(GENERAL)/BBA/BCA/Honours Course under the Choice Based Credit System that stands fixed as having passed 50% of the credits, shall be rounded off to the nearest lower side where 50% of the credits come to be an odd number and where no permutation/combination of subjects/papers makes it to that odd number of credits. For example, where a course is of 22 credits and 50% of credits is in odd number (11 credits), the eligibility shall be rounded off to 10 credits; and
3. the eligibility condition of having passed in the internal assessment in atleast 75% of the subjects/papers of Semester-II/IV of the B.A./B.SC./B.COM. (GENERAL)/BBA/BCA/Honours Course for admission to Semester-III & V respectively under the CBCS shall also be applicable to the Semester System students (Non-CBCS).

3.8.1 Considered the confirmation of the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having authorized the following:

- a) in the present and similar cases of Under Graduate Courses, where the subject wise re-evaluation awards are almost 100% or more in variation for 10% of the total copies in that subject, a third evaluation shall be followed and the average of the nearest of the two of the three evaluations be awarded. In the cases where the difference is equal in all the three evaluations, average of the three be awarded;
- b) The evaluation of copies/scripts shall be made mandatory to atleast 300 copies in an academic year for all the faculty members; and
